

AGRICULTURAL UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFIT

INGLESE - ENGLISH

 Are you an agricultural worker who has been dismissed or whose contract has expired?

 You may be entitled to receive agricultural unemployment benefits
You must file your application before **31st march**

Which workers does this apply to?

- ✓ Temporary workers (O.T.D.).
- ✓ Seasonal workers employed full time (O.T.I.).

If you are an immigrant worker, you must have a residency permit for subordinate employment or as a person awaiting employment.

When are you eligible for unemployment benefits?

- ✓ Dismissal ✓ Expiry of your contract.

If you are a subordinate immigrant worker and have lost your job, you can be listed in the Jobseeker's register for the time remaining on your permit and in all cases for a period no shorter than one year. Bear in mind you can hold a residency permit as a person awaiting employment and which you can renew. Before your residency permit expires, come to our offices to ask for all the information you need.

You may be entitled to the following benefits

- ✓ Agricultural unemployment benefits: your application can only be sent electronically to Inps. You can do this from our offices.

When can you apply?

- ✓ Your application must be presented before March 31st of the year following the one during which you were dismissed or your contract expired.
- ✓ So you must submit your unemployment claim for the previous year by March 31st, otherwise you lose the right.

When are you not eligible for unemployment benefits?

- ✓ Voluntary resignation (with the exception, under specific conditions, of working mothers with a child under the age of one).
- ✓ If you are an immigrant worker with a seasonal work permit (from 20 days to 9 months, but with the obligation to return to your own country).
